

Barbados Has No Ratified Extradition and Arrest Warrant Treaty - The Downfall of the Barbados Labor Party (BLP)

Barbados quickly accepted liability when the story broke, after someone posted their findings on social media, they could not then risk a cover up, as a probe was swiftly conducted into the suite of Treaties and found since the 1990s when the current Barbados representative was attorney general and every successive one since then, they never ratified the Extradition and Arrest Warrant under the Treaty of Chaguaramas, making it difficult to explain away why there was no due process in the victim's "kidnapping."
