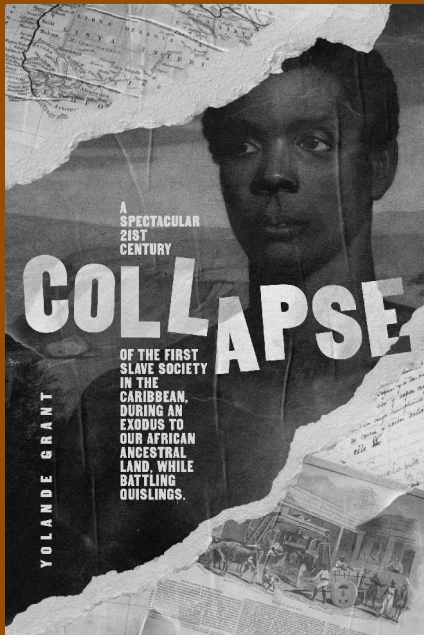

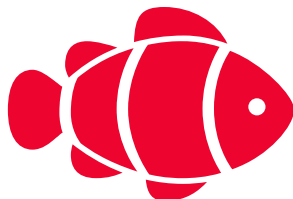

### **The Right to Food and Housing**

The twin island nation was the very first to start oil production locally, long before Arab states. In contrast, Barbados has one oil terminal that barely survived being pilfered and sold to a Canadian company some years ago, if certain people had not been vigilant. 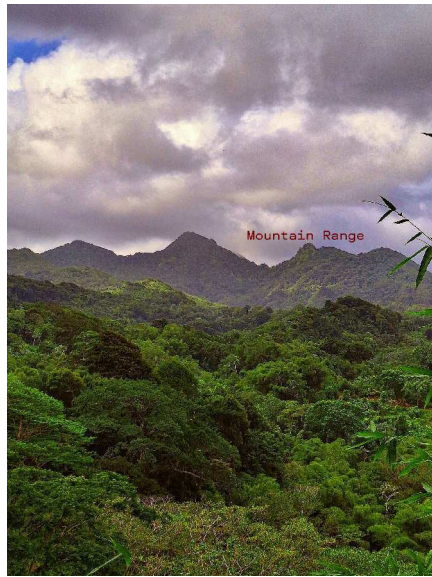
