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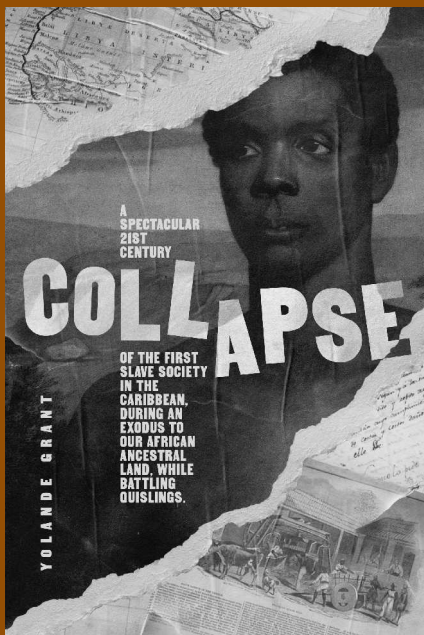

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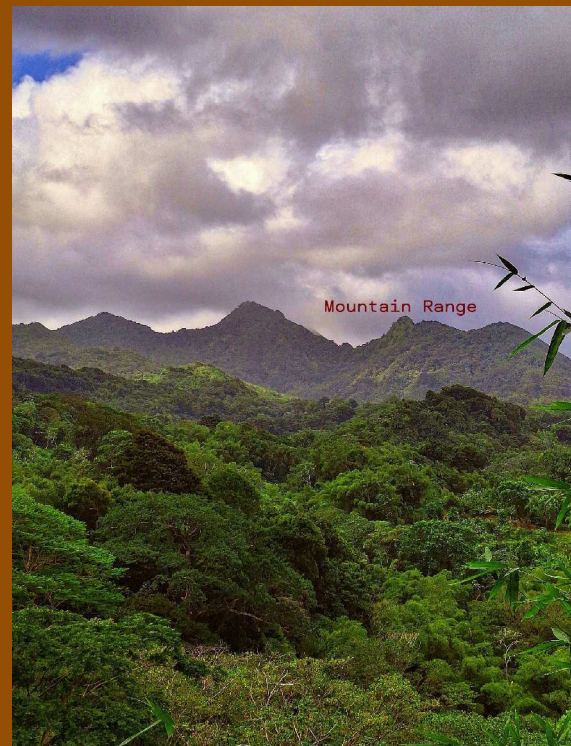

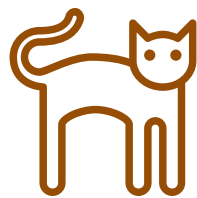




Afrikans Must Fix What They Broke Between Themselves And Black Americans
