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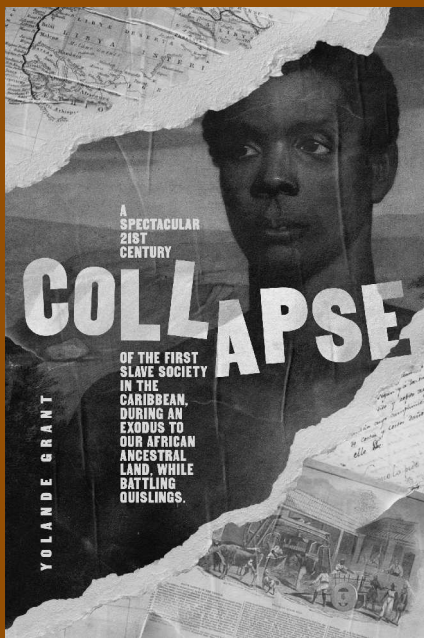

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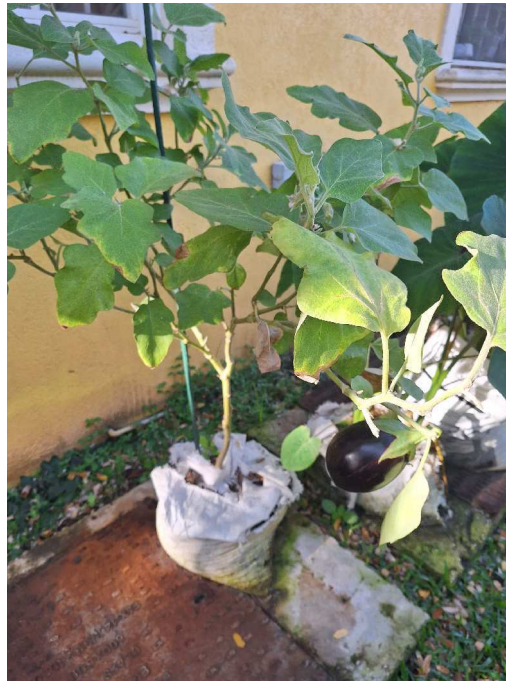

End Of Slavery In The United States

After the United States was founded in 1776, the country split into slave states (states permitting slavery) and free states (states prohibiting slavery). Slavery became concentrated in the Southern United States. The Act Prohibiting Importation of Slaves banned the Atlantic slave trade starting in 1808, but not the domestic slave trade or slavery itself. Slavery was finally ended throughout the entire country after the American Civil War, in which the US government defeated a confederation of rebelling slave states that attempted to secede from the U.S. During the war, U.S president Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation, which ordered the liberation of all slaves in rebelling states.

In December 1865, the Thirteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution was ratified, abolishing chattel slavery nationwide. Native American slave ownership also persisted until 1866, when the federal government negotiated new treaties with the "Five Civilized Tribes," in which they agreed to end slavery. Some argue slavery continues to exist because the Thirteenth Amendment contains an exception for people convicted of a crime.:"

The fact that an Afrikan president ignored this, or knows nothing about it, yet seeks to massage us with political balm and a mis-shapen narrative, is highly disturbing. 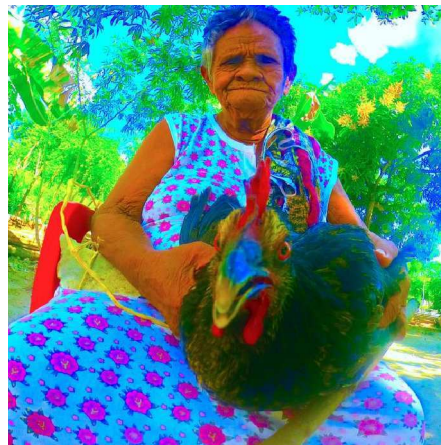




Know Ourstory, And History
