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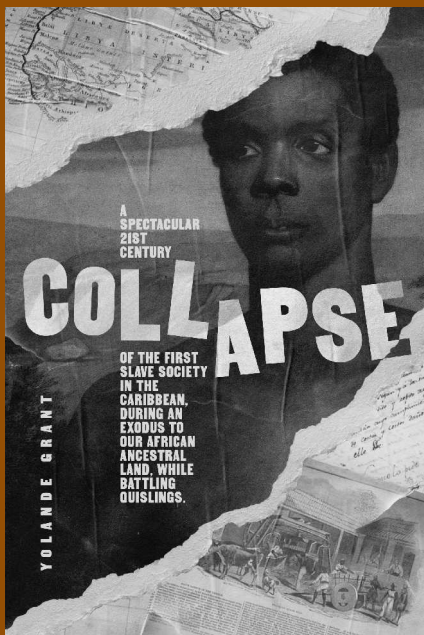

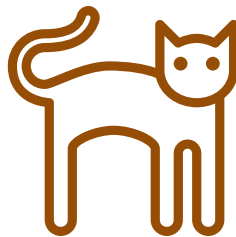

**The Ashanti King, Descendant Of 17th Century Historical Ghanaian
Slavers

When the Ashanti was brought to Barbados in February of 2026 with much fanfare, we were sure it was by government invitation. Some people felt uncomfortable just by the presence, and the strong aura released. Although there was only the usual boilerplate information supplied by wikipedia when researching, nothing too in depth to alert anyone to his real background was available. However, what was revealed was more than enough to wonder exactly what he was doing on the island, touring the Caribbean, and giving a speech before the election that no one was interested in hearing.

By the time September 2026 rolled around, the representative from Ghana found himself at Howard University in the US waxing philosophical about unity among Black Americans and Afrikans that had already seen over two decades of escalating verbal clashes and rising hostilities due to the attitudes of Afrikans who reside in the US, believing they are superior to Black people in the diaspora and could dictate to, demean and denigrate Americans in videos, with threats and bullying.

None of which was acknowledged, mentioned or chastised by the Ashanti leader: while acting as the moral authority on unification. To be honest, he is more needed on the continent, to permanently remove the cycles of abhorrent detestation Afrikans now have for each other, that was poured across our ancestral space when apparently, no one was paying attention.



What happened in the US was due in part to Ghana's unceasing dismissive and negative actions against Afrikan Americans, the outcome was predictable. We are aware many people from this region tried to connect with the leaders over many years, so Afrikan countries would welcome us as direct bloodline descendants and were openly refused. Afrika claimed they had no interest, the answer was a resounding no delivered to those who tried. So what is the Ashanti king doing in this region acting as though he is taking charge? Although knowing about the court's decision handed down, also impacting any reparation talks held by Caricom countries with anyone, in effect rendering them all worthless. The problem is not the subject matter but the politicians who continue to act like descendants of slavery should have no direct involvement in anything.

When we do have a right to say and demand Afrika is held accountable with all others whose ancestors took part. His ancestors were employees of Elmina castle and other surrounding administrative locations built by colonizers all along the region of Ghana's Cote d'or, and also Cote d'Ivoire. Somehow, Barbados never mentioned that crucial detail to the population in warning, nor did other Caricom member states relay it to the people who are their employers as well.

They all obviously came to the consensus that anything relevant should be omitted, concealed with everyone kept in the dark, and egotistically taking it upon themselves to decide we did not need to know.

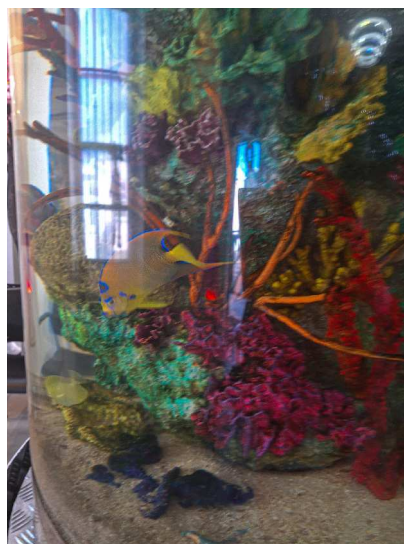
